# **Activity Shuttle Buses**

Activity Shuttle Buses will be provided for Junior High and High School students involved in extracurricular activity practices at the end of the school day. The bus(es) will leave the junior high school in Roseville at approximately 5:00 p.m. Delivery of the Junior High School students back to Monmouth will be at approximately 5:25 p.m. at the Monmouth-Roseville High School parking lot. **There will not be access to a telephone on the student's return to Monmouth.** 

The shuttle buses will then load up High School students returning to Roseville and will leave Monmouth from the high school building and/or Sunnylane Field at approximately 5:30 p.m. with the anticipated arrival at Monmouth-Roseville Junior High School in Roseville at 5:50 p.m.

# Early Dismissal Cancellation of School.

Parents and Students are asked to check the District's website at <a href="www.mr238.org">www.mr238.org</a>, listen to WMOI/WRAM in Monmouth and to watch for announcements on social media and Quad Cities television stations for early dismissal and cancellation announcements. The decision to cancel school for weather-related reasons is normally before 6:00 a.m. The District will also use the all-call system to notify parents by phone of any school cancellation, delays, or early dismissals.
